

LOTSAs 2023 323 Tournament

Rules:

1. All registrations must be made online thru the LOTSAs website
2. To participate in this Tournament, you must also be registered in the LOTSAs Salmon Tournament
3. All teams who register must provide a working cell phone number that can accept text messages so LOTSAs Tournament Control can keep everyone up to date on any delays or cancellations.
4. Every Person on Board MUST be a VALID LOTSAs member by the day prior to the event. This includes those covered under the LOTSAs Family Membership who must be entered into the LOTSAs Family Membership by the day prior to the Event.
5. Boundaries -Lake Ontario. All government (US and CAN) regulations for boating & fishing apply.
6. This is a 3 fish tournament taking place over both Friday and Saturday – you do not have to fish both days to enter. If the Friday Tournament is canceled, this will be a one-day tournament and be run with the LOTSAs Salmon Tournament.
7. Two of the fish must be Salmon. One of the fish weighed can be a trout of any species (brown, steelhead, laker).
8. Once a fish is weighed in for the 323 it cannot be replaced by a larger fish on day 2.
9. Fish must be weighed in on the day they are caught – not legal to hold a fish from the first day and weigh it on the second day.
10. The winners will be determined by combined weight of the 3 fish. In the event of a tie for a certain place we will add both prizes together and split evenly.
11. A contending fish must be caught by hook and line, retrieved by rod and reel, on angling tackle. Any fish having cuts, gaff marks, gill net or puncture marks anywhere on the body will be questioned.
12. No fishing lines may be in the water prior to the Start time (6am unless changed by Text for weather).
13. All coolers must be in the weigh in line to be checked in by the End time (3pm unless changed by text for weather).
14. Weigh In & Check In:

- When arriving for weigh in check, please have your fish clearly identified. Weigh in staff will not weigh multiple fish to determine which one is bigger. (Zip Tie in the jaw is ok for identifying purposes)
- Cooler may not have standing water in it where fish are covered or floating in any manner. Bagged ice or other contained ice is ok to keep fish cold. Before arriving to check in drain cooler of any excess water.
- Captain must be present at check in to sign check in documentation

15. Any changes to Start or End times because of weather will be communicated by the tournament committee to all boats using the supplied phone number via text no later than 5:15am for the Start time and throughout the day if necessary.

16. It is at the discretion of the LOTSA Tournament Committee to disqualify any team for violation of any of these rules including altering the weight of the fish or lines in before 6am start time - etc.

Weather: In the interest of safety, and in consideration of the smaller boats utilized by many members of the club, the LOTSA Tournament Committee may cancel the days fishing if they determine that the lake is unsafe to fish for all entrants. The LOTSA Tournament Committee may also make the decision to delay/shorten/change the fishing hours in the interest of safety. In the event the entire tournament is canceled, the tournament fee will be refunded.
